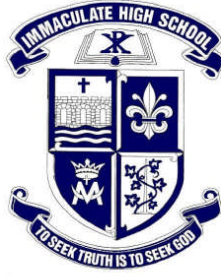

The Immaculate High School Alumni Association Scholarship

Two (2) \$500.00 scholarships are awarded each year to students who are or will be attending Immaculate High School. The criteria are as follows:

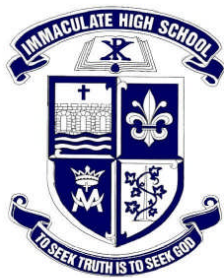
1. The first scholarship is awarded to a deposited incoming member of the new freshman class. This student must be a child of a Immaculate High School alum.
2. The second scholarship is granted to the previous year's freshman recipient, provided he/she maintained a "B" average (3.0) in his/her freshman year.
3. Awards received will be applied against the tuition account for the current school year.

Application process:

1. Applicant must be deposited at Immaculate High School for the upcoming school year.
2. Applicant must submit a three-paragraph essay stating why he/she chose Immaculate High School and why being a part of the Immaculate family is important.

Application for scholarship should be sent to: Immaculate High School, Attn: Office of the President, no later than March 1, 2010. Scholarship(s) will be awarded in May 2010

NOTE: A Private School Aid Service (PSAS) form must be completed and submitted directly to PSAS in order to be eligible for all need-based scholarships.



David R. Couch Memorial Scholarship

The David R. Couch Memorial Scholarship is a need-based scholarship available to deposited incoming students at Immaculate High School. The award is valued at one-half of the tuition fee established for the 2010-2011 school year. These awards are applied to first year tuition.

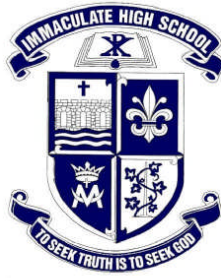
The David R. Couch Memorial scholarship bears the name of its benefactor who taught at Immaculate High School for 35 years. Mr. Couch created this need-based scholarship to fund school tuition for students who would not be able to attend Immaculate High School without financial aid.

Application process:

1. Applicant must be deposited at Immaculate High School for the upcoming school year.
2. Applicant must have completed and submitted the PSAS (Private School Aid Service) application.
3. Applicant must submit a one-page essay, written legibly in his/her own hand, stating the reason(s) why he/she wants to attend Immaculate High School. The essay should also outline the student's extra curricular activities and community service.
4. Applicant should submit a recommendation from his/her current principal or a teacher.

Application for scholarship should be sent to: Immaculate High School, Attn: Office of the President, no later than March 1, 2010. Scholarships will be awarded in May 2010.

NOTE: A Private School Aid Service (PSAS) form must be completed and submitted directly to PSAS in order to be eligible for all need-based scholarships.



Isabelle Farrington Scholarship

The Isabelle Farrington Scholarship Fund has been established to provide scholarships to deposited incoming IHS freshmen who meet the below academic criteria and have need. The awards of \$1,500 each are applied to first year tuition.

Selection of candidates for these scholarships is based on the following criteria:

1. Rank among the top 25% of his/her eighth grade class.
2. Demonstration of a sincere interest in, and practice of, the principles of citizenship and religion, for which Immaculate High School has been established as a Diocesan School of the Roman Catholic Church.
3. Demonstrated financial need.

Application process:

1. Applicant must be deposited at Immaculate High School for the upcoming school year.
2. Applicant must submit a one-page essay, stating why he/she believes he/she meets the above-listed criteria and why he/she wishes to attend Immaculate High School.

Application for scholarship should be sent to: Immaculate High School, Attn: Office of the President, no later than March 1, 2010. Scholarships will be awarded in May 2010.

Gregory Todd LaBonne Memorial Scholarship

The Gregory Todd LaBonne Memorial Scholarship is a need-based scholarship available to deposited incoming freshmen at IHS. The award is valued at one-half of the tuition fee established for the 2010-2011 school year. These awards are applied to first year tuition.

Selection of candidates for these scholarships is based on the following criteria:

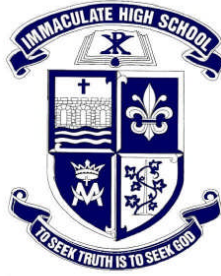
1. A student from any elementary/middle school in the greater Danbury area that IHS serves who, but for the ability to pay the full tuition, is accepted at IHS.
2. Student must express a strong desire to attend Immaculate High School and become an active member of the IHS community. (i.e. participate in extracurricular activities, etc.)
3. Student must possess potential to achieve and maintain satisfactory grades.

Application process:

1. Applicant must be deposited at Immaculate High School for the upcoming school year.
2. Applicant must submit a one-page essay, stating why he/she believes he/she meets the above-listed criteria and why he/she wishes to attend Immaculate High School.

Application for scholarship should be sent to: Immaculate High School, Attn: Office of the President, no later than March 1, 2010. Scholarships will be awarded in May 2010.

Mark McGetrick Scholarship

The McGetrick Scholarship is a need-based scholarship available to deposited incoming IHS freshmen. The award is valued at \$1,500 and is applied toward first year tuition.

The Mark McGetrick Scholarship has been established by the McGetrick family in memory of their son Mark. The letters of Mark's name define the overall criteria for the award...

Merit + Ambition + Reliability + Kindness...

The IHS Recommendation Committee will consist of an IHS Administrator, a member of the IHS Guidance Department, an Honor Society moderator and the Campus Minister. The Recommendation Committee will submit their recommendation to the administrator of the McGetrick Family fund for final selection of recipient.

To apply for this scholarship:

1. Applicant must be deposited at Immaculate High School for the upcoming school year.
2. Applicant must submit a one-page essay, stating why he/she believes they embody the spirit of the award (*Merit + Ambition + Reliability + Kindness*) and why they wish to attend Immaculate High School.
3. Applicant's current elementary school principal must submit a cover letter attesting to academic rank and sincerity of student.

Application for scholarship should be sent to: Immaculate High School, Attn: Office of the President, no later than March 1, 2010. Scholarships will be awarded in May 2010.

NOTE: A Private School Aid Service (PSAS) form must be completed and submitted directly to PSAS in order to be eligible for all need-based scholarships.



Immaculate High School Presidential Scholarship

The IHS Presidential Scholarship is a merit and need-based partial scholarship available to deposited incoming freshmen. The award is \$2,000 per year for each of the four years. Recipients must maintain at least a “B” average (3.0) for each school year. These awards are applied annually against current year’s tuition.

Selection of candidates for these scholarships is based on the following criteria:

1. Rank among the top 3 students or top 10% of his/her eighth grade class.
2. Academic merit in math and science as demonstrated by high grades, plus any projects and/or special achievement activities in these subject area(s).
3. Demonstration of a sincere interest in, and practice of, the principles of citizenship and religion, for which Immaculate High School has been established as a Diocesan School of the Roman Catholic Church.

The President will select the recipient based on recommendation of the selection committee, which consists of the Principal, Asst. Principal, a senior Math/Science teacher, the Director of Guidance, and the IHS Chaplain.

Application process:

1. Applicant must be deposited at Immaculate High School for the upcoming school year.
2. Applicant must submit a one-page essay, stating why he/she believes he/she meets the above-listed criteria and why he/she wishes to attend Immaculate High School.
3. Applicant’s current elementary school principal must submit a cover letter attesting to academic rank and sincerity of student.

Application for scholarship should be sent to: Immaculate High School, Attn: Office of the President, no later than March 1, 2010. Scholarships will be awarded in May 2010.
